
- Training objectives

 - Note compass direction when facing the yard from the control panel
 - Show understanding of how to arrive/depart trains
 - Show how to log-on a departing train
 - Show how to log-off a terminated train



West Desert Yard

- West yard limit
 - Switch 201 (Oakland Pier) & 203 (Desert Yard) should be left thrown to main
 - Westbound departing trains will need to take crossover switch 203 and route through Oakland Industrial – check for opposing traffic
 - Note compass direction








Desert Yard – West Approach

- •Switch 205 Desert Yard



Desert Yard Panel








Desert Yard - East Approach

- East yard limit
